



ABAC officially joined the NAIA in July 2024 and competes in the Southern States Athletic Conference (SSAC). The college features several intercollegiate sports, including basketball, tennis, cross country, softball, baseball, women's soccer, and men's golf, which now compete at a higher, four-year level of competition.

- **NAIA Membership:** ABAC became an official NAIA member on July 1, 2024.
- **Conference Affiliation:** The college joined the Southern States Athletic Conference (SSAC) at the same time and began competing in the 2024-25 academic year.
- **Athletic Programs:** ABAC has 10 intercollegiate sports for men and women, such as baseball, basketball, softball, and tennis.
- **Transition:** The move to the NAIA marks a significant transition for ABAC's athletics to a four-year level of competition, replacing its previous two-year status.

Due to ABAC not having been a member of NAIA for a full year in 2024, the Equity in Athletics Disclosure Act (EADA) report was not required for 2024.
